What you will do	You will meet with other members of the Group, and Saffron staff, to discuss issues and to make recommendations for improvements.
	To do this you will be expected to examine and understand Saffron's performance as a housing provider and play an active role in making challenging decisions.
Responsible to	Service Quality Committee
Where and when you will do it	We will need your time for eight set meetings per year, four in person and four virtual and ad-hoc meetings which may arise. You will be supported to contribute to discussions and express your views clearly.
	We will also need a time commitment of at least 1-3 hours per week – this will include time for reading, responding to emails or any training. You can do it from the comfort of your own home.
